1. Given $f(x) = \frac{2x+1}{3}$

$$f(7) = \frac{2 \times 7 + 1}{3}$$

$$= \frac{14 + 1}{3}$$

$$= \frac{15}{3} \quad 5$$

(b) Find $f^{-1}(x)$

$$y = \frac{2x+1}{3}$$

$$3y = 2x + 1$$

$$3y - 1 = 2x$$

$$\frac{3y - 1}{2} = x \quad (2)$$

$$f^{-1}(x) = \frac{3x - 1}{2}$$

2. The functions $f(x)$ and $g(x)$ are given by the following:

$$f(x) = 3x - 1$$

$$g(x) = 2x + 4$$

(a) Calculate the value of $fg(2)$

$$g(2) = 2 \times 2 + 4 = 8$$

$$f(8) = 3 \times 8 - 1 = 23$$

$$fg(2) = 23$$

(b) Calculate the value of $ff(3)$

$$f(3) = 3 \times 3 - 1 = 8$$

$$f(8) = 23$$

(c) Find $gf(x)$

$$gf(x) = 2(3x - 1) + 4$$

$$gf(x) = 6x - 2 + 4$$

$$= 6x + 2$$

$$gf(x) = 6x + 2$$

3. The functions $f(x)$, $g(x)$ and $h(x)$ are given by the following:

$$f(x) = x^2 - 3$$

$$g(x) = 2x + 1$$

$$h(x) = \frac{x}{2}$$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{(a) Find } fg(x) &= (2x+1)^2 - 3 \\ &= (2x+1)(2x+1) - 3 \\ &= 4x^2 + 4x + 1 - 3 \end{aligned}$$

$$fg(x) = 4x^2 + 4x - 2 \quad (2)$$

$$\text{(b) Find } gh(x) = 2\left(\frac{x}{2}\right) + 1 = x + 1$$

$$gh(x) = x + 1 \quad (2)$$

$$\text{(c) Find } f^{-1}(x) \quad \begin{aligned} y &= x^2 - 3 \\ y+3 &= x^2 \\ \sqrt{y+3} &= x \end{aligned}$$

$$f^{-1}(x) = \sqrt{x+3} \quad \text{where } x \geq -3 \quad (2)$$

4. The function f is such that $f(x) = 4x - 7$

$$\text{(a) Solve } f(x) = 17 \quad 4x - 7 = 17$$

$$4x = 24$$

$$x = 6$$

$$x = 6 \quad (2)$$

$$\text{(b) Find } f^{-1}(x) \quad y = 4x - 7$$

$$y+7 = 4x$$

$$\frac{y+7}{4} = x$$

$$f^{-1}(x) = \frac{x+7}{4} \quad (2)$$

5. Given $f(x) = x^2 + 2$ and $g(x) = x + 14$

Find the values of a such that $f(a) = g(a)$

$$\begin{aligned}a^2 + 2 &= a + 14 \\a^2 - a - 12 &= 0 \\(a-4)(a+3) &= 0\end{aligned}$$

$$a = 4 \text{ or } -3$$

6. The functions $f(x)$ and $g(x)$ are given by the following:

$$f(x) = 8 - 3x$$

$$g(x) = 4x$$

(a) Calculate the value of $gf(3)$

$$f(3) = 8 - (3 \times 3) = -1$$

$$g(-1) = 4 \times -1$$

-4

(b) Solve the equation $gf(x) = 80$

$$gf(x) = 4(8 - 3x) = 32 - 12x$$

$$32 - 12x = 80$$

$$-48 = 12x$$

$$x = -4$$

7. $f(x) = 2x^2 - 1$

$$y = 2x^2 - 1$$

Find $f^{-1}(x)$

$$\begin{aligned}y + 1 &= 2x^2 \\ \frac{y+1}{2} &= x^2\end{aligned}$$

$$f^{-1}(x) = \sqrt{\frac{y+1}{2}}$$

(3)

$$\sqrt{\frac{y+1}{2}} = x$$

where $x \geq -1$

8. Given $f(x) = x^2 + 3x - 5$

Express $f(2x - 1)$ in the form $ax^2 + bx + c$

$$\begin{aligned}
 f(2x-1) &= (2x-1)^2 + 3(2x-1) - 5 \\
 &= (2x-1)(2x-1) + 6x - 3 - 5 \\
 &= 4x^2 - 4x + 1 + 6x - 8 \\
 &= 4x^2 + 2x - 7
 \end{aligned}
 \quad \text{.....} \quad \begin{matrix} 4x^2 + 2x - 7 \\ \hline (3) \end{matrix}$$

9. The function f is such that $f(x) = kx + 3$

The function g is such that $g(x) = 2x - 4$

Given that $gf(2) = 34$

work out the value of k

$$\begin{aligned}
 gf(x) &= 2(kx+3)-4 = 2kx+6-4 \\
 &= 2kx+2
 \end{aligned}$$

$$gf(2) = 4k+2 = 34$$

$$k = 8$$

.....

10. For all values of x ,

$$f(x) = x^2 + 4$$

$$g(x) = x - 9$$

$$\begin{aligned}
 gf(x) &= (x^2 + 4) - 9 \\
 &= x^2 - 5
 \end{aligned}$$

Solve $fg(x) = gf(x)$

$$\begin{aligned}
 fg(x) &= (x-9)^2 + 4 \\
 &= (x-9)(x-9) + 4 \\
 &= x^2 - 18x + 81 + 4 \\
 &= x^2 - 18x + 85
 \end{aligned}$$

$$fg(x) = gf(x)$$

$$\begin{aligned}
 x^2 - 18x + 85 &= x^2 - 5 \\
 -18x + 85 &= -5 \\
 -18x &= -90
 \end{aligned}$$

$x = 5$

.....

$$11. \quad f(x) = x^2 + 2x + 1$$

Show that $f(x+2) - f(x) = 4x + 8$

$$f(x) = x^2 + 2x + 1$$

$$f(x+2) = (x+2)^2 + 2(x+2) + 1$$

$$= x^2 + 4x + 4 + 2x + 4 + 1$$

$$= x^2 + 6x + 9$$

$$f(x+2) - f(x) = 4x + 8 \quad QED$$
